Train: There is a regular service to Cambridge from London and also excellent cross-country trains to many UK destinations. The railway station is approx. a 15-20 minute walk from the city centre and there are plenty of buses and taxis available. <http://www.nationalrail.co.uk>

Bus: The main city bus station is on Drummer Street in the city centre, about a 20 minute walk from the conference venue.

Car: Cambridge is easily accessed via the M11. There is parking at the Doubletree by Hilton Hotel (a reasonable fee applies), but generally parking in the city centre is very limited.

Air: London Stansted is the nearest airport to Cambridge and is just 30 miles south of the city. Regular buses and trains (approx. 30 minutes journey) run from Stansted to central Cambridge. There are also bus connections from London Heathrow and London Gatwick.
